

Forget-Me-Not Hat

a pattern created for and dedicated to the volunteers of AllCrafts4Charity.org,
who always remember the children. (revised 2/2005)

fingering weight (small preemie):

US C/D crochet hook

yarn:

white - 1 ounce

yellow - a few yards

blue - a few yards

gauge: 11 dc = 5 cm (2")

DK weight (medium/large preemie):

US E/F crochet hook

yarn:

white - 1 ounce

yellow - a few yards

blue - a few yards

gauge: 9 dc = 5 cm (2")

worsted weight (newborn):

US F/G crochet hook

yarn:

white - 1 ounce

yellow - a few yards

blue - a few yards

gauge: 6.5 dc = 5 cm (2")

all yarn requirements are approximate

flower motif

(use smaller hook – make a band of 8):

rnd 1: with yellow, ch 4 and sl st to form a ring. *sc into center of ring. ch 2. repeat from * 4 times (5 small loops created).
sl st to top of first sc. tie off and clip. weave in ends.

rnd 2: attach blue to one of the loops with a sl st. *ch 2. 4 dc. ch 2. sl st into loop and in next loop. repeat from * for all loops. (5 petals created). tie off and clip. weave in ends.

hat:

ch 60. sl st in first ch to join.

* ch 2. dc in each st around. sl st in top of ch 2 to join.

rvs sc around.

loosely sl st tbl of each stitch in the prev row.

ch 3. 3 dc in same st. *ch 2. skip 2 sl st. sc in next sl st. ch 2. skip 2 sl st. 4 dc in next sl st. repeat from * around. end with ch 2 and sl st in top of the ch 3.

sl st in next dc. sc between 2nd and 3rd dcs of group. *ch 4. sc in next sc. ch 4. sc between middle 2 dc. repeat from * around. end ch 4. sc in next sc. ch 4. sl st in 1st sc.

* ch 3. *4 tr in next sc. ch 2. sc in next sc. ch 2. repeat from * around. end 4 tr, ch 2. sc in bottom of ch 3.

ch 5. sc between 2nd and 3rd tr of group. *ch 4. sc in next sc. ch 4. sc between middle 2 tr. ch 5. sc in next sc. ch 5. repeat from * around. end ch 5. sl st in 1st ch of ch 5.

ch 3. 3 tr in same st. *ch 2. sc in next sc. ch 2. 4 tr in next sc. repeat from * around. end with ch 2 and sl st in top of the ch 3.

sl st in next tr. sc between 2nd and 3rd tr of group. *ch 3. sc in next sc. ch 3. sc between middle 2 tr. repeat from * around. end ch 3. sc in next sc. ch 3. sl st in 1st sc.

ch 3. *4 dc in next sc. ch 2. sc in next sc. ch 2. repeat from * around. end 4 dc, ch 2. sc in bottom of ch 3.

ch 4. sc between 2nd and 3rd dcs of group. *ch 3. sc in next sc. ch 3. sc between middle 2 dc. repeat from * around. end ch 3. sc in next sc. ch 3. sl st in bottom of ch 3.

ch 3. 2 dc in same st. *ch 2. sc in next sc. ch 2. 3 dc in next sc. repeat from * around. end with ch 2 and sl st in top of the ch 3.

sl st in top of 3 dc. sl st into ch 2 space. *insert hook through the ch 2 space and draw up a loop. insert hook through the next ch 2 sp and draw up a loop. yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook. ch 4. repeat from * around. end with ch 4, sl st in first decrease. (10 ch-4 spaces)

ch 3. 2 dc in the same stitch. *ch 1. 3 dc in next stitch. end sl st in top of ch 3.

sl st next 2 dc. sc in same st. *ch 3. sl st in center dc. repeat from * around. end ch 3. sl st in first sc.

sl st into ch space. ch 2. 1 hdc in next space. *2 hdc in next space. repeat from * around. sl st in top of ch 3.

ch 1. make a dec in each 2 stitches around. sl st in top of ch 2.

finishing:

tie off. clip, leaving a 12" tail. from inside, thread through the top of each stitch. draw tightly closed. weave in end and clip.

using yellow yarn, tack the flower (through the center) to the front-side of the hat, just above the dc round.

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abbreviations:

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

dec: single crochet decrease

hdc: half double crochet

rvs sc: reverse single crochet

sc: single crochet

sk: skip

sl st: slip stitch

tbl: through back loop

tr: treble crochet

yo: yarn over

note: ch X at beginning of any round will count as a stitch, except for a ch 1.

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
