Forget-Me-Not Slippers

a pattern created for and dedicated to the volunteers of AllCrafts4Charity.org, who always remember the children. (revised 2/2005)

fingering weight (small preemie):

US C/D crochet hook yarn: white - $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce

yellow - a few yards blue - a few yards gauge: 11 dc = 5 cm (2'')

DK weight (medium/large preemie):

US E/F crochet hook

yarn: white - 1/2 ounce yellow - a few yards blue - a few yards

gauge: 9 dc = 5 cm (2'')

worsted weight (newborn):

US F/G crochet hook

yarn: white - $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce yellow - a few yards blue - a few yards

gauge: 6.5 dc = 5 cm (2'')

abbreviations:

ch: chain dc: double crochet dec: decrease dtr: double treble hdc: half double crochet rvs sc: reverse single crochet

sc: single crochet sk: skip sl st: slip stitch tbl: through back loop tr: treble crochet yo: yarn over note: ch X at beginning of any round will count as a stitch, except for a ch 1.

flower motif (use smaller hook and make a band of 8):

rnd 1: with yellow, ch 4 and sl st to form a ring. *sc into center of ring. ch 2. repeat from * 4 times (5 small loops created).

sl st to top of first sc. tie off and clip. weave in ends.

rnd 2: attach blue to one of the loops with a sl st. *ch 2. 4 dc. ch 2. sl st into loop and in next loop. repeat © 2003 Rights from * for all loops. (5 petals created). tie off and clip. weave in ends.

the slipper

when attaching the flowers, sl st in the top "bump" on the back of the dc.

ch 13. sl st in topmost dc of lower right petal. ch 1. sl st in each dc of the next petal. ch 1 (repeat twice). ch 1. sl st in topmost dc of lower left petal. ch 12. sl st to 1st chain to join. ch 4. sl st in same stitch with loop facing downward. (loop for tie created)

- ch 2. hdc in each st around.
- ch 2. 15 hdc. dec, 2 dc, 3 dec (across 6 stitches), 2 dc, dec, 14 dc. sl st in top of ch 2.
- ch 2. 12 hdc tbl. 6 dec (across 12 stitches). 12 hdc tbl.
- 23 ch 1. sc dec. sc to last 2 stitches. sc dec. tie off and clip. leave 6" tail and weave sole of slipper closed.
- 23 pull ribbon through loop at center back of heel. criss-cross over top of slipper. end by weaving one end through to the other side and tie in a bow on the side of the slipper.

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
