Holiday Hats

sizes: preemie sm, (preemie med/newborn)

for older baby/toddler sizes, use worsted weight yarn and 4.5mm & 5.0 mm (US 6 & 8) needles

needed:

3.5mm & 4.25mm (us 4 & 6) double-point or circular knitting needles

MC: ½ ounce DK/light worsted weight yarn

C1: ¼ ounce C2: ¼ ounce optional: 1/2" button

gauge: 11 st/ 13 r = 2" with DK yarn and US 6 needles

all yarn requirements are approximate

abbreviations: p: pu

MC: main color ssk: slip 2 stitches, separately and knitwise, then knit them together

k: knit through their back loopsk2tog: knit 2 stitches togethers/ X: slip X stitch(es), purlwise

and with yarn in back, unless otherwise noted



instructions:

as one

picot edge:

with MC and smaller needles, cast on 48 (56, 64) using a provisional cast on.

Divide equally across needles. Join, taking care not to twist.

k around for 4 rounds.

remove provisional anchor and transfer sts in sections to a spare dpn or circular needle.

fold over the newly picked up stitches and needle to the outside (purl side of work will be the "right" side) and hold needle parallel to the needle with the stitches to be worked next.

knit together 1 stitch from each needle until all stitches on needle are worked. repeat process for 2nd and 3rd needles.

rolled edge

with MC, k around for 4 rounds.

crown:

k one round

attach C1. k 4 rounds

pick up MC. *k 3. allow next stitch to drop (unknit) 4 rows (back to MC row). insert needle into the stitch in the MC row below the dropped stitch and knit, capturing the loose threads of the dropped C1 stitch. repeat from * around.

k one round

slip 2 stitches (these will be worked at the end of the round). attach C2. k 4 rounds. break C2.

pick up MC. beginning with the first stitch after the slipped stitches, *k 3. allow next stitch to drop (unknit) 4 rows (back to MC row). insert needle into the stitch in the MC row below the dropped stitch and knit, capturing the loose threads of the dropped C2 stitch. repeat from * around. break C2. attach C1. k 4 rounds. break C1.

pick up MC. *k 3. allow next stitch to drop (unknit) 4 rows (back to MC row). insert needle into the stitch in the MC row below the dropped stitch and knit, capturing the loose threads of the dropped C1 stitch. repeat from * around.

k 12 (15/18) rounds.

decreases:

*ssk, k10 (12, 14). repeat from * around

*ssk, k9 (11, 13). repeat from * around

*ssk, k8 (10, 12). repeat from * around

*ssk, k7 (9, 11). repeat from * around

*ssk, k6 (8, 10). repeat from * around

*ssk, k5 (7, 9). repeat from * around

*ssk, k4 (6, 8). repeat from * around

*ssk, k3 (5, 7). repeat from * around

*ssk, k2 (4, 6), repeat from * around

*ssk, k1 (3, 5). repeat from * around

for size medium & large, continue in established decrease pattern until only 8 st remain.

clip, leaving a 12" tail. draw through loops remaining on needles. tighten and tie off. weave in end.

finishing options:

oreate one or more pom poms and fasten securely to top of hat.

create a loopy topper

ear flap and closure

using C1 or C2, attach to inside edge of hat and pick up 9 stitches.

k1, p1 4 times. slip last stitch. turn. repeat for 6 rows.

k1, ssk, k, k2tog, sl. turn.

tie closure--

ssk, k, k2tog. turn.

make a 3-stitch i-cord that is 12" long.

weave in end.

button closure --

k1, p1 twice. slip last stitch. turn repeat until chin strap is desired length (5 1/2 - 6 - 6 1/2 inches from ear flap)

make button hole - k1, p1, bind off 1, p1, sl

k1, p1, yo, p1, sl 1. turn.

k across

repeat last 3 rows.

cast off - ssk, k1, k2tog.

tie off and weave in end.

skip 5 (6/7) "dots" from the first flap and create a 2nd flap. if using chin strap, sew button on 2nd flap.
