Striped Ribs Hat

sizes: baby/toddler/child (adjustments for larger sizes in parenthesis)

approximate yardage:

child - 80 yards/40 yards CC toddler - 70 yards MC/40 yards CC baby - 60 yards/ 30 yards CC

gauge (unstretched, in ribbed pattern):

worsted:4" = 20 st/24 rows chunky: 4" = 18 st/22 rows

abbreviations: rnd(s): round(s)

CC - contrasting colour

k: knit

MC - main colour

ndl(s): needle(s)

p: purl

rnd(s): round(s)

ssk: slip 2 stitches, separately
and knitwise, then knit
them together through
their back loops
st(s): stitches



pattern info by size:

basic pattern:

note: because of the colorwork, there is significantly less elasticity in the ribbing than usual

Cast stitches, with smaller needles, according to the size chart.

- Join into a circle, being careful not to twist.
- 12 (14, 16) rnds: k2 with MC, p2 with CC

DESIGNER'S TIP: when working colorwork patterns in the round and the spans between color changes are 3 stitches or less, first work the round in one color (slipping the stitches for the "other" color) then repeat for the 2nd color. Be sure there is ease in the yarn when carrying it behind the slipped stitches, especially when working ribbed patterns.

- with MC and larger needles, k around
- 2 rnds: with CC, p arounds. clip CC
- with MC, p around decreasing 2 (4, 0) stitches evenly. 78 (84, 96) stitches remain
- k around for 10 (12, 15) rounds or until hat is about 2" from desired finished size, including ribbing.

decreases:

row 1: *ssk, k 11 (12, 14). repeat from * around. row 2: *ssk, k 10 (11, 13). repeat from * around. row 3: *ssk, k 9 (10, 12). repeat from * around. row 4: *ssk, k 8 (9, 11). repeat from * around.

row 5: *ssk, k 7 (8, 10). repeat from * around.

row 6: *ssk, k 6 (7, 9). repeat from * around.

row 7: *ssk, k 5 (6, 8). repeat from * around.

row 8: *ssk, k 4 (5, 7). repeat from * around.

row 9: *ssk, k 3 (4, 6). repeat from * around.

row 10: *ssk, k 2 (3, 5). repeat from * around.

row 11: *ssk, k 1 (2, 4). repeat from * around.

row 12: (toddler/child only) s*sk, k0 (1, 3). repeat from * around.

row 13: *(child only)* *ssk, k0 (0, 3). repeat from * around. break MC, leaving a 12" tail.

finishing:

- weave through remaining loops.
- tie off and weave in ends.
- add your favorite topper



pcake style: shown preemie sized, knit with fingering yarr 5 mm needles and finished with a red topknot
