# **Purple Project Newborn Hat II**

needed:

 dpns or circular needles – 3.5mm (US 4) or size necessary to achieve gauge

 DK weight yarn: newborn:

MC: 90 yards

gauge: 34 sts/34 rows in stitch pattern

wall yarn requirements are approximate

## abbreviations & special stitches:

**RT3:** K3tog, leave sts on LH needle. YO, knit first st. Allow all 3 stitches to slip from LH needle.

**RT2:** K3tog, leave sts on LH needle. Knit first st. Allow all 3 stitches to slip from LH needle. (1 st decreased)

**S2KP:** Slip 2 stitches purlwise. K1. Pass slipped stitches over just-worked st. Centered double decrease.

k: knit p: purl k2tog: knit two stitches together as one. k3tog: knit three stitches together as one. rnd: round sts: stitches

#### Faux Cable Stitch notes

#### 8 stitch repeat

This stitch pattern is a multiple of 8, so it's easy to adjust your cast on to make larger or smaller sizes.

twist round:

\*k1, p2, RT3, p2. Repeat from \*around.

#### **Optional Top Knot**

If top knot is desired, work the following ( steps aft.er decrease round 18

- It around for 20 rnds.
- k2tog for one round (5 sts remain)
- Inish as usual, then tie i-cordinto a knot.

# Instructions

- Cast on 88 sts. 1-10: \*K1, p2, k3, p2. Repeat from around.
- 11: \*k1, p2, RT3, p2. Repeat from \*around. (twist rnd)
- 12-19: \*K1, p2, k3, p2. Repeat from \* around.

20: \*k1, p2, RT3, p2. Repeat from \*around. (twist rnd)

21-27: \*K1, p2, k3, p2. Repeat from \* around.

Hat should be approx. 3 ½" from cast on edge.

#### Decreases:

- 1: \*K1, p2, RT2, p2. Repeat from \*around. (77 sts)
- 2-5: \*K1, p2, k2, p2. Repeat from \* around.
- 6: \*k1, p2tog, k2, p2tog. Repeat from \* around. (55 st)
- 7: \*k1, p1, k2tog, p1. Repeat from \*around. (43 st)

- 8-10: \*K1, p1, Repeat from \* around.
- 17: k1. Slip just-worked stitch to RH needle (end of round)

\*p1. S2KP. Repeat from \* around. (21 sts)

 k3tog. \*K2tog in remaining sts around. (10 sts)

## Finishing:

clip yarn leaving 6" tail. draw tail through loops

tie off. weave in all ends.

This hat stretches to 15". The depth is approx  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " from top to cast on edge
