

## Toddler Tubies (toe up)

sized for med -- (small, large) in parenthesis.  
as always easy to alter, must be done on a multiple of 4

### Materials:

4/5 double point needles, size 3.75, 4.25 mm (US 5, 6)  
Color A: approx 1 ¼ ounce worsted weight yarn  
Color B: approx ¾ ounce worsted weight yarn  
(gauge: 4" = 20 st/22 r using 4.25mm (US 6) needles  
pictured with Lion Brand Fishermen's Wool)



### Instructions:

With Color A and larger needles, cast on 12 (12,16) stitches (6 (6,8,) on each needle). I like to hold the 2 needles parallel to each other, casting the 1st on the left, the 2nd on the right and so on.

round 1: knit around

round 2: 1st needle: k1, inc 1, k across to last stitch, inc 1, k1. 2nd needle: k1, inc 1, k across to last stitch, inc 1, k1

repeat rows 1 and 2 until the total number of stitches needed

32 (24, 36) stitches total - 10/10/12 (8/8/8, 12/12/12) on each needle

### pattern:

Color A

round 1/2: k3, s1 around

round 3: k around

Change to Color B

round 4/5: k1, s1, \*k3, s1. Repeat from \*around, ending with k2

round 6: k around

continue in pattern, alternating colors as indicated, until foot/leg is desired length less 2". I used 10 pattern repeats for the socks in the picture. Twist and carry unused color between rows.

### finishing:

change to smaller needles

k1, p1 ribbing around for 2" (approx 20 rows)

cast off (I like to do this with a larger size needles)

Weave all ends through inside of stitches to secure. Clip.

Weave in end from cast on stitches and clip.
