Spring Fling Socks

a quick (2 - 2 1/2 hours) pair of socks sized for a small/med preemie --(newborn) in parenthesis.

Materials:

4 double point needles 2.75 mm (US 2) (with the tiny size, I find I can work these best with only 4)

MC: approx 1/2 ounce sports-weight/baby yarn Color A/B/C: approx 10 yards contrasting Stitch Key: sports-weight/baby yarn (gauge: 17 st/ 20 r = 2")

Color Parrot Green Violet Pink

Instructions:

With Color A, cast on 12 (16) stitches (6 (8) on each needle). I like to hold the 2 needles parallel to each other, casting the 1st on the left, the 2nd on the right and so on.

round 2 and 3: 1st needle: k1, inc 1, k across, inc 1, k1. 2nd needle: k1, inc 1, k across, inc 1, k1 round 4 (newborn only): repeat previous round. 24 (32) stitches total - 12 (16) on each needle

C 2007 Rese All Rights Rese at this point, split work onto 3 needles - 6 (8) stitches each on #1 and #2 (top) and 12 (16) on #3 (bottom)

Change to MC knit 14 (20) rows change to Color A

short row heel

knit across first two needles. Knit across needle #3 until last stitch. wrap last stitch, turn row 1: (remainder of heel will beworked on bottom needle only)

- slip just-wrapped stitch and purl across stitches just worked until last stitch. row 2: wrap last stitch, turn.
- slip just-wrapped stitch and knit next 10 (14) stitches. row 3: wrap next stitch, turn.

continue in this manner until 6 (8) stitches remain unworked in the center

heel turning:

row 1: k6 (8), wrap next stitch, turn (wrapped stitch will have 2 loops)

row 2: p7 (9), wrap next stitch, turn.

row 3: k8 (10), wrap next stitch, turn

continue in this manner until all stitches have been worked

leg/finishing:

round 1: knitting on all needles again, knit around with MC round 2: with Color B, purl around

round 3: with MC, knit around

round 4/5: Checkerboard - knit 2 with MC, knit 2 with Color C, around

round 6/7: Checkerboard - knit 2 with Color C, knit 2 with MC, around

round 8/9: with MC, knit around

round 10: with Color B, purl around

round 11/12: with MC, purl around

cast off (I like to do this with a larger size needles)
